Tour 1: Thursday 03 October 2019, Historic St. Augustine

Tour covers 450 years of colorful history: The Ponce de Leon discovery, the pirate days of Sir Francis Drake, the Spanish and English colonial years, and the Victorian Flagler era. We tour all the major sites and stop at the Castillo de San Marcos, the fort that was never captured in battle. St. Augustine was also the first winter resort for the rich and famous during the Gilded Age. Hear how Henry Flagler built the most opulent hotels of the day and turned the city into the “Newport of the South.” The second stop will be the Venetian Renaissance gem of Flagler Memorial Church. Your guide creates an interactive tour atmosphere which is fun for everyone.

Tour 2: Friday 04 October, 2019, Mayport Naval Station, Veterans Memorial Wall, Lunch

Commissioned in December 1942, Naval Station Mayport has grown to become the third largest fleet concentration area in the United States. Mayport's operational composition is unique, with a busy harbor capable of accommodating 34 ships and an 8,000-foot runway capable of handling any aircraft in the Department of Defense inventory.

With more than 3,400 acres, Naval Station Mayport is host to more than 80 tenant commands including 22 naval ships and six Light Airborne Multi-purpose System (LAMPS) Mark III helicopter squadrons. Naval Station Mayport is also the operational and training headquarters for the SH-60B Seahawk LAMPS MKIII with a primary mission of anti-submarine warfare. It is the third largest Naval Facility in the continental United States. As a major Surface and Air Warfare organization, Naval Station Mayport remains dedicated to providing the "Finest Service to the Finest Fleet," as it grows into the 21st century.

Enjoy lunch overlooking the Atlantic Ocean at Ocean Breezes, the former Officer's Club.

We will also have a brief stop at the Chief's Club to pay respects and view the mirrored wall with the names of those who perished aboard the USS Forrestal during the ship's 38 years of service.

After departing Naval Station Mayport, we will visit the Jacksonville Veteran's Memorial Wall in downtown Jacksonville. This Memorial Wall is unique in that it lists the veterans of Duval County who have died during wartime service organized by the high schools which they attended.
